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Czech Legislation

- 1990: Act No. 171/1990 Coll., on the System of Primary and Secondary Education: "the Deaf... have the right to be educated in their own language by Sign Language"
- 1998: Act No. 155/1998 Coll., on Sign Language, in force till 2008
- 2008: Act No. 155/1998 Coll., on Communication Systems of the Deaf, as amended by Act No. 384/2008 Coll., in force since 2009



Special Service at the Czech Universities

- counselling centres:
 - applicants, students, third parts searching for information
 - general counselling (educational, legal, social, psychological, carrier)
 - for students with special needs
- service centres for students with special needs
- 2013 Association of Service Providers for University Students with Special Needs (AP3SP, 12 member universities)

Interpreting at the Czech Universities

- initially just individual and occasional
- 1992 internal interpreter at Janáček Academy of Performing Arts in Brno (Educational Drama)
- 1997 occasional interpreting at Palacký University in Olomouc
- 1998 interpreting at Masaryk University and Charles University (*Deaf Studies*), occasionally at other universities (Sign Language Act)
- 2003 systematic service by Teiresias Centre, MU, later at other Czech universities




Financing the interpreters

- initially mostly individual (including private service)
- 2010 practical service offered by Teiresias Centre shadowed by the Ministry of Education, leeding to an agreement on national financing by public budget
- 2011 Principles of the financing and special grants provided to public universities by the Ministry of Education; Supplement 3: Financing of the extra costs for students with special needs, p. 31-58.

Interpreting Service

Czech-Norwegian comparison	Czech Republic	Norway
Population	10 millions	5 millions
Number of primary sign language users	8,000	5,000
Number of sign language interpreters	40-70	600

- real-time communication service (students, lecturers, teachers, other staff)
- text translations
- increasing demands on education of interpreters



Education of interpreters

- local education (community institutions and agencies)
- 1998 curriculum of Czech in the Communication of the Deaf at the Faculty of Arts of Charles University
- 2000 The Czech Chamber of Sign Language Interpreters
- 2004 Certified study programme for interpreters of Czech Sign Language at the Czech Chamber
- 2007 The Deaf Institute for specialized training (specialized courses for interpreters)



Education of interpreters (cont'd)

- 2010 Universal learning design innovation in interpreting and communication services at MU (grant by European Social Fund)
- 2012 Network of Expert Centres Providing Inclusion in Tertiary Education at MU (grant by ESF)
- 2016 Deaf College in Hradec Králové, post-secondary study programme Czech Sign Language Interpreting has been accredited and is about to start
- currently accreditation processes of study programs Czech Sign Language Interpreting at Charles University, Masaryk University and Palacký University (ESF)

Other issues

- accessibility of basic information for applicants
- preparing for the study at university
- accessible tests (Learning Potential Test)
- accessible study documents in Czech Sign Language (Hybrid Book)
- competency in Czech Sign Language
- Online Thesaurus of Czech Sign Language (*Dictio*)
- specialized language courses (Czech, English)
- mobility and international sign languages (ASL, IS)
- speech-to-text reporting and note-keeping
- individual teaching
